Subject:- Inclusion/ Recognition of UG (BAMS) Medical Qualification of Ayurveda degree awarded by Lucknow University, under Section 35 of the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine Act, 2020 - reg.

With reference to the subject mentioned above I am directed to inform you that as per the erstwhile CCIM, the qualifications/degree are recognized/included under Second Schedule to the IMCC Act 1970. Now as the erstwhile CCIM has been repealed the degrees/qualifications included under schedule-II shall be maintained as it is and there shall not be any further additions/insertions/modifications. The newly formed NCISM act provides the provision of recognizing the qualifications/degrees under section 35. Hence inclusion of qualification/degree shall be under section-35.

Sub: Standard Operating Procedures (SOP) for the verification of On Paper Interns – reg.

In compliance to the Regulation 27 (s) of National Commission for Indian System of Medicine (Ethics and Registration) regulation, 2023 and as per the approval of Commission in its 20th meeting, **Commission Unanimously decided to conduct inspection of ASU&SR Institutions**, where Institution are allowing Intern to be on-paper (Physically absent only on paper), also giving them internship completion certificates, despite not completing Compulsory Rotatory Internship and without compliance of Regulation 15, i.e., "Compulsory Rotatory Internship" of the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine (Minimum Standards of Undergraduate Ayurveda Education) Regulations-2022 and Regulation 14 of National Commission for Indian System of Medicine (Minimum Standards of Undergraduate Unani/Siddha/Sowa-Rigpa Education), Regulations-2022.

In this context, Commission has made penalty provisions under the Regulation 27 (s) of NCISM (Ethics and Registration) regulation, 2023 for On-paper interns and institutions where on-paper interns (Physically absent only on paper) will be found.

Furthermore regulation 27 (s) of National Commission for Indian System of Medicine (Ethics and Registration) Regulation 2023 also conferred power to **Board of Ethics and Registration and State ISM Council** to conduct inspections to identify and curb the misconducts in respect of On-paper Interns.

For the Strict implementation of Regulation 27 (s) of National Commission for Indian System of Medicine (Ethics and Registration) Regulation 2023 and to restrain from On-paper Interns activities, letter was sent to all the ASU&SR Institutions vide letter ref. no **20-28/2024-Regn (PR), Dated: 01.08.2024.**

Therefore, for the Implementation of Regulation 27 (s) of National Commission for Indian System of Medicine (Ethics and Registration) Regulation 2023, Board of Ethics and Registration is hereby issuing Standard Operating Procedures (SOP) for the verification of On-Paper Interns. All the respective Institutions are requested to kindly adhere with the Standard Operating Procedures (SOP)

**Standard Operating Procedures (SOP) for the verification of On-Paper
Internees**

In compliance to the Regulation 27 (s) of National Commission for Indian System of Medicine (Ethics and Registration) regulation, 2023 and as per the approval of Commission in its 20th meeting. **Commission Unanimously decided to conduct inspection of ASU&SR Institutions**, where Institution are allowing Intern to be on-paper (Physically absent only on paper), also giving them internship completion certificates, despite not completing Compulsory Rotatory Internship and without compliance of Regulation 15 , i.e., "Compulsory Rotatory Internship" of the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine (Minimum Standards of Undergraduate Ayurveda Education) Regulations-2022 and Regulation 14 of National Commission for Indian System of Medicine (Minimum Standards of Undergraduate Unani/Siddha/Sowa-Rigpa Education), Regulations-2022.

In this context, Commission has made penalty provisions under the Regulation 27 (s) of NCISM (Ethics and Registration) regulation, 2023 for On-paper interns and institutions where on-paper interns (Physically absent only on paper) will be found.

“ When the Board finds that an intern with provisional registration, who is required to undertake internship, has obtained his internship certificate by fraud or misrepresentation or without fulfilling the requisite attendance requirement in this behalf or by providing false information with respect to attendance either in collusion with the respective institution or otherwise or without fulfilling the requirements as specified under the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine (Minimum Standards of Undergraduate Ayurveda Education) Regulations, 2022, The National Commission for Indian System of Medicine (Minimum Standards of Undergraduate Unani Education) Regulations, 2022, The National Commission for Indian System of Medicine (Minimum Standards of Undergraduate Siddha Education) Regulations, 2022, The National Commission for Indian System of Medicine (Minimum Standards of Undergraduate Sowa Rigpa Education) Regulations, 2022 or any such guidelines as notified in this regard by the Commission from time to time, then such intern shall be penalised with suspension of his provisional registration for the duration of not less than six months and on the completion of the suspension period, such intern shall start his internship of one year afresh and when the inquiry committee holds an intern to be liable for the violation of this regulation, the Board shall penalise such institution with a penalty of not less than five lakhs rupees for every single case of violation”.

Furthermore regulation 27 (s) of National Commission for Indian System of Medicine (Ethics and Registration) Regulation 2023 also conferred power to **Board of Ethics and Registration and State ISM Council** to conduct inspections to identify and curb the misconducts in respect of On-paper Interns.

For the Strict implementation of Regulation 27 (s) of National Commission for Indian System of Medicine (Ethics and Registration) Regulation 2023 and to restrain from On-paper

Interns activities, letter was sent to all the ASU&SR Institutions vide letter ref. no **20-28/2024-Regn (PR)**. Dated: **01.08.2024**.

In this Regard for the Implementation of Regulation 27 (s) of National Commission for Indian System of Medicine (Ethics and Registration) Regulation 2023, Board of Ethics and Registration is hereby issuing Standard Operating Procedures (SOP) for the verification of On-Paper Internees.

- Verification of the Interns, who are physically absent but present only On-paper will be considered Suo-moto either by Board of Ethics and Registration for Indian System of Medicine randomly or on receiving any complaints against any particular Intern Student or Institution by Board of Ethics and Registration for Indian System of Medicine/National Commission for Indian System of Medicine.
- Verification of Intern will be done by the President / Members of Board of Ethics and Registration, NCISM or any person authorized by the Board of Ethics and Registration, Representative from Concerned State ISM Registration Council and Representative from Govt. ASUS Institutions.

RESPONSIBILITY OF INTERNEES

- Intern should comply with the directions given in the regulation 15 of National Commission for Indian System of Medicine (Minimum Standards of Undergraduate Ayurveda Education) Regulations-2022 and Regulation 14 of National Commission for Indian System of Medicine (Minimum Standards of Undergraduate Unani/Siddha/Sowa-Rigpa Education), Regulations-2022 (For Unani/Siddha/Sowa-Rigpa System of Medicine Interns).
- Intern should have the copy of Provisional Degree Certificate from the respective universities either in soft (In the Mobile phone) or Hard copy.
- Intern should have the copy of Provisional Registration Certificates from respective State Board or Council for Compulsory Rotatory Internship either in soft (In the Mobile phone) or Hard copy.
- The interns shall mandatorily attend the orientation programme regarding internship and a e-logbook shall be maintained by each intern, in which the intern shall enter date-wise details of activities undertaken by him during orientation.
- The intern shall maintain a e-logbook containing all the activities undertaken by intern during internship.
- It shall be compulsory for an intern to maintain the record of procedures done/assisted/observed by him on day-to-day basis in a specified e-logbook and the intern shall maintain a record of work, which is to be verified and certified by the Medical Officer or Head of the Unit or Department under whom he works.

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- Visitation team shall have the discretion of verifying attendance of Interns and all other relevant documents.

RESPONSIBILITY AND PROCEDURE FOR VERIFICATION TEAM

- The Visitation for this purpose shall be surprise
- The verification team Shall Consist Minimum 03 persons.
- The Visitation team shall enter in the hospital at around 09:30 to 10:00AM
- Initially the visitation team shall meet the principal/Dean/Director (Head of Institution) and show their authorization letter.
- Visitation shall be conducted during OPD Hours.
- The verification team shall verify the presence & duties of all interns as per the duty roaster.
- The verification team shall take a Geo-tag photograph with all interns.
- When a verification team undertakes a physical verification of a hospital, particularly in respect of interns, ethical and moral considerations must be followed. These principles ensure that the process is fair, transparent, and respectful:
 - All interactions with interns, faculty, and staff should be conducted respectfully, maintaining the dignity of all individuals involved.
 - The team should conduct the verification process with the highest level of honesty, ensuring that all findings are reported accurately and without bias.
 - The team must be impartial and objective, avoiding any favoritism or discrimination based on personal relationships, affiliations, or biases.
 - All interns and college staff should be treated equally during the verification process, with no undue advantage or disadvantage given to any individual.
 - The team should respect the privacy of interns and staff, ensuring that any personal or sensitive information gathered during the verification is kept confidential.
 - The verification process should be conducted meticulously, ensuring that all relevant aspects are examined thoroughly without rushing or overlooking details.
 - Reports generated from the verification process should reflect the true findings without exaggeration, omission, or distortion of facts.
- Verification team shall have the power to verify the attendance register of Interns.
- Verification team shall inspect the documents as cited above in the RESPONSIBILITY OF ASU&SR INSTIUTION.
- After the verification done, verification team should make report on the same day duly signed on each page with all the verification team member.
- Report should be submitted to the President, Board of Ethics and Registration, Plot No. T-19, 2nd, Floor, Block_IV Dhanwantari Bhawan, Road No 66, Punjabi Bagh(West), New Delhi-110026 Delhi through Email.
- Team members should be accountable for their actions and decisions during the verification process.

Board of Ethics and Registration for Indian System of Medicine will initiate action against the Intern & Institution if it is proved that he/she is physically absent but present only on paper.

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All the Interns are directed to comply with directives given in respect of Internship in the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine (Minimum Standards of Undergraduate Ayurveda/Unani/Siddha & Sowa-Rigpa Education) Regulations-2022 and Cooperate with the verification team sent by the Board of Ethics and Registration, if any inquiry related to their regularity in the Institution or other related to above mentioned is made.

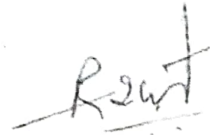
- All documents related to the intern should be available with the College authority like: -
 - Details of Interns including (Mobile Number & Email-ID)
 - Provisional Degree Certificate
 - Provisional Registration Certificates from respective State Board or Council.
 - Joining Report.
 - Duty Roaster of Intern.
 - Orientations Program details
 - Details of Migrated Students (if any).
 - E-Log Book record
 - Leave record
 - Documents for substantiating regular attendance –
 - a) CCTV Camera Footage of regular attendance of the Intern since joining.
 - b) Bio-Metric Attendance.
 - c) Google Timeline for regular travel from residence to college since joining.
 - d) Photograph of the Student with Geotag.
 - Place of Internship with record.
- It is a responsibility of the Institution to make arrangement for Videographer & Photographer during the verification made by Board of Ethics and Registration, NCISM in respect of Interns for Preparing group photograph with interns (the name of each intern should be mentioned in the bottom of Photograph).
- **It shall be mandatory for the hospital superintendent, Principal and HOD to provide all the relevant documents, when asked by the verification team without any undue delay.**
- **All Institutions are requested to cooperate with the verification team (for Interns) sent by the Board of Ethics and Registration, National Commission for Indian System of Medicine, New Delhi.**

Note*

- Team Shall Consist of 03 Members
- Visitation will be surprise
- Visitation shall be for one day
- Visitation shall be conducted during OPD Hours.

D. S. J.

1. As per regulation 27 (s) of NCISM (Ethics and Registration) Regulation 2023, **such intern shall be penalised with suspension of his provisional registration by the State registration authority for the duration of not less than six months and on the completion of the suspension period, such intern shall start his internship of one year afresh.**
2. As per regulation 27 (s) of NCISM (Ethics and Registration) Regulation 2023, when the inquiry committee holds an intern of an institution to be liable for the violation of the regulation, the Board shall penalise such institution **with a penalty of not less than five lakhs rupees for every single case of violation.**
3. **If institution does not pay the penalty amount the recommendation will be sent to the, NCISM to withheld the permission for that particular session and subsequent session till remittance of the penalty amount.**
4. As per section 24 (3) of National Commission for Indian System of Medicine, Act 2020. Intern and Institution has a liberty to prefer an appeal to the Commission against the decision taken by the Board of Ethics and Registration within thirty days of the communication of such decision.
